Wave 1 In-Home Survey

Main sample, used for control variables and outcomes

Wave 1 Friends Survey

Used to identify student peers

Wave 1 School-Information

Used to identify religious schools

Details on the selection and coding of the relevant variables are shown in the Stata do-file “data_prepare.do”. This do-file describes how to get from the original Wave I data to the dataset dbn.dta that we used for the regression analysis. The averages among the peers are obtained using the information on the nominated friends, which is available directly in the hfriend1.dta (Wave 1 Friends Survey). We have included a sample dbn.dta. Observe that **aid** is the unique student identifier, while **scid** is the school id.

Once dbn.dta is obtained, we detail below how to get to the results of the paper, table by table.
